

**NTA Policy Regarding Tournaments Points Awarding System**  
**Effective from: April 5, 2026**

The NTA has established a policy and tournament point awards system taking into account past established system to which changes have been made to ensure fair point awarding. In order to promote the growth in tennis in Nepal and for the benefit of the players, NTA will be establishing a fair tournament points awarding system that promotes and encourages Nepal's player participation in the international tennis events. **However, as international tournaments points allocation still needs to be properly formulated; this has been put on hold until further notice.**

**A. Points for Men's and Women's tournament players (Singles and Doubles):** will be based on tournament prize money as shown in tables below:

The following procedures and regulations will be followed by NTA for awarding points:

1. All national tournaments in Nepal will be graded with varying points based on the numerous factors as determined under the Tournament Grading Policy and Regulations.
2. NTA is working on establishing a proper points allocation methodology for participation in International tournaments (WTTJ/ATP/WTA/ITF - ATF Junior); hence, the allocation of international tournament points are kept on hold until further notice. (Revised 6/1/2026)
3. NTA ranking will take into account the points of best 6 (six) tournament results played in National level. (Revised 6/1/2026)
4. A total of approximated 15 months is considered for accumulation of points including the National Games. However, any event will not be counted twice within the 15-month period.
5. In the Men's and Women's categories NTA will reduce the awarded points by 50% if the draw size consists of only 4 participants provided all 4 players have played. No points will be awarded if there are less than 4 participants.
